Tulsa Girls Art School's mission: Through art, Tulsa girls overcome barriers and discover life-changing purpose, power and possibility!

The Art School began in 2007 with the original purpose of providing an after-school program in a safe, encouraging and instructive environment for underprivileged girls to develop their artistic ability and to eventually teach them the basics of business and money. The organization has evolved and grown, and although the original purpose remains and art is still the medium, the program has expanded to serve the whole girl as expressed by its mission statement. Some students may become successful artists and some will prosper in other areas as the program teaches critical thinking, artistic and social skills, discipline and financial management to help them succeed in life.

The school welcomes girls from third grade through twelfth grade, allowing some students to have nearly ten years of programming and consistent support. All transportation, supplies, space, instruction and snacks are provided free of charge.

In addition to local outings, the older students take a summer trip where they attend galleries, museums, and fine arts education programs in many different cities. For some, it is the first time to travel outside their neighborhood and new worlds and aspirations are opened to them.

Students prepare art exhibits of their work for the public and receive a portion of their art sale proceeds which is maintained in micro-savings accounts for each.
